As per your request for supporting documentation, please find a list of the documents we have supplied as alternatives to a full birth certificate. Although I am aware an Affidavit is sufficient alone, I have however included other documents for your reference.

- 1) An Affidavit of Birth, signed and notarised, a legal document that can be used to verify the facts surrounding an individual's birth, including birth date, location, and the name of each parent
- 2) NN4B Birth Notification clearly showing the date, time of my babies birth, hospital ID and NHS number along with my, the mothers details, name, date of birth, NHS number, hospital patient ID
- 3) A letter received from the Consultant from her check up at xxxxx on the xxxxx
- 4) Birth Details & Newborn Examination Record by Dr xxxxxx
- 5) Discharge Summary by Midwife xxxxxx
- 6) Discharge Advice Letter

All the above documents are the originals that were given to me as they are, either via post or hand delivered and that I forward onto you.

Please note as most hospitals are now digital with hand written notes fast becoming almost obsolete the majority of our notes, the **NN4B Birth Notification** form for example was collected electronically and printed off for me at my request.

The British Nationality Act 1981 <https://www.legislation.gov.uk/ukpga/1981/61> copied below states:

PART I
British Citizenship
Acquisition after commencement

1 Acquisition by birth or adoption.

(1) A person born in the United Kingdom after commencement [F1, or in a qualifying territory on or after the appointed day,] shall be a British citizen if at the time of the birth his father or mother is —

(a) **a British citizen**; or

(b) settled in the United Kingdom [F2or that territory].

Both Mother xxxxxxxxxx and Father xxxxxxxxxx according to the Government are British Citizens, passport details provided below:

2. We have accepted irrevocable Power of Attorney over our children's well-being and property until the eighteenth anniversary of their birth.

I trust this presentment meets with all reasonable requirements and I look forward to receiving a United Kingdom Passport in due course.
